9 Fitzroy Square was designed by Robert Adam as one of a row of houses on the eastern side of Fitzroy Square. Designed in the neoclassical style, the houses were built speculatively to attract wealthy aristocratic families.

The house, which is Grade II\* listed by Historic England, is now the British Cardiovascular Society headquarters, and we are delighted to offer our historic meeting rooms at affordable prices. Hire a room with a history!









### **Paul Wood Room**

Capacity: 18 - 20 boardroom style



The Paul Wood Room is our main meeting room and is named after Dr Paul Wood (1907 - 1962), who was renowned worldwide for his skills as a teacher and clinical cardiologist.

He left a legacy of great accomplishments as the transition figure between the old and modern era of cardiology. His portrait illustrates the tools available for making a diagnosis.

The room is large and airy, and includes easy-to-use AV facilities, which allows you to seamlessly integrate virtual attendees into the meeting via Microsoft Teams.

Bookings include self-service refreshments with a coffee machine and hot water dispenser.



### **Mackenzie Room**

Capacity: 8 - 10 boardroom style



The Mackenzie Room is named after Sir James Mackenzie (1853 - 1925), who was the father of British cardiology and the inspiring teacher of several members of the original Cardiac Club.

The room houses the library and many documents relating to the history of the British Cardiovascular Society, including the original letters written between Mackenzie and Sir Thomas Lewis.

This room is smaller and suitable for more intimate meetings of up to 10 people and features a projector, making presentations easy.



## **Thomas Lewis Room**

Capacity: 20 boardroom style



The Thomas Lewis Room is our secondary meeting room and is named after Sir Thomas Lewis (1881 - 1945), who was a clinical scientist more than a cardiologist, renowned for his application of electrocardiography to clinical medicine.

The room houses much of the BCS archives including pacemakers, Waller's original recording apparatus and archaic defibrillators.

This room features a microphone and projector, allowing you to integrate online participants into the meeting (please note there is no meeting room camera).
